4.COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE: -GDC Magam provides counselling to students on moral and ethical values and to inculcate proper values for better understanding to prevent ragging.

REPORT

Awareness Programme

GDC Magam hosted an anti-ragging awareness program on 3rd November 2024 under the Chairmanship of Principal Prof. Dr. Tasleema Bano, with an importance on fostering a safe, respectful, and wide-ranging educational environment. The event was attended by faculty, administrative staff, and a large gathering of students from various departments.

The convener in her address highlighted the harmful impact of ragging on the mental and emotional well-being of the students. They also shared real-life incidents of how ragging had adversely affected students in different institutions across the country, thus helping students understand the significance of the issue.

Speakers discussed the legal implications related with ragging, detailing specific laws and punishments outlined by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and local authorities to deter such behavior. The program highlighted how engaging in ragging can lead to suspension, expulsion, and even criminal charges, making it clear that the college stands firmly against any form of ragging.

In addition to the convener's speech, senior students were encouraged to share their positive practices to build solidarity without harassment.

A short documentary on anti-ragging was screened to further raise awareness and showcase the severe consequences faced by offenders.

Dr. Tasleema Bano the principal of GDC Magam, in her concluding remarks, encouraged students to support and uplift each other, highlighted that GDC Magam strives to be a community where every student feels respected and safe. She repeated that any form of ragging, bullying, or harassment would be met with strict action, aligning with the college's guidelines and protocols.
